## Float Glass

- Most Economical Option
- When it breaks it will shatter into large, sharp pieces

## Toughened Glass

- Grade A Safety Glass
- Greater heat resistant properties
- When it breaks it will shatter into small, granular pieces

## Laminate Glass

- Grade A Safety Glass
- Helps protect carpets, curtains and furniture by blocking out 99 % of UV Light
- When it breaks it will remain intact in the opening
- Effective in reducing Noise (Acoustics)

## Low E Glass

- Provides increased levels of Solar Control
- Provides increased levels of Thermal Control
- Available in Float, Toughened or Laminate Glass

## Acoustic Glass

- Grade A Safety Glass
- Specifically designed to reduce noise levels
- Available Laminate Glass Only

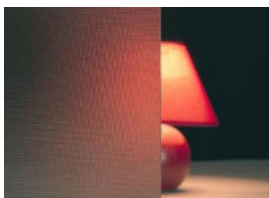

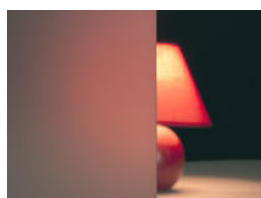

## Obscure Glass

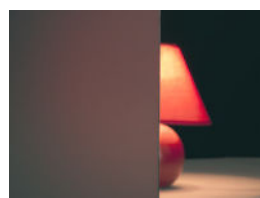
- Provides increased levels of privacy and glare reduction
- Available in Float, Toughened (SatinLite and Acid Etched) or Laminate Glass (White Translucent Only)



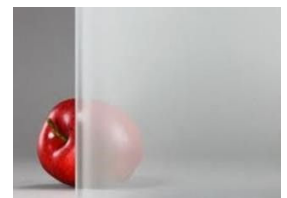
Satinlite
